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CAMDEN COALITION NAMES DR. JUBRIL OYEYEMI AS NEW MEDICAL DIRECTOR

Virtua physician and Cherry Hill Free Clinic founder joins Camden Coalition to support interdisciplinary care coordination and clinical innovation efforts

CAMDEN, NJ – The Camden Coalition of Healthcare Providers today announced the selection of Dr. Jubril Oyeyemi as Medical Director to support the organization’s care coordination and pilot interventions for patients with complex health and social needs. Dr. Oyeyemi will join the Camden Coalition’s interdisciplinary team of nurses and community health workers as medical advisor.

Dr. Oyeyemi is an Associate Medical Director for Virtua Medical Group, treating patients as both a hospitalist and a primary care physician. He is also the founder and Chief Medical Officer of the Cherry Hill Free Clinic.

“Dr. Oyeyemi stood out for his dedication to the community and passion for patients’ wellbeing,” said Camden Coalition CEO Kathleen Noonan. “He has a wealth of experience, and we are excited to have a physician join us from Virtua, one of our partner South Jersey health systems.”

“I’m grateful for the opportunity to contribute to the Camden Coalition’s thoughtful and innovative agenda,” said Dr. Oyeyemi. “Throughout my career, I have worked to bring patients the highest level of care no matter the circumstances, and I’m eager to continue providing that level of care to the Camden Coalition’s patient population.”

Dr. Oyeyemi has been a valued member of the Virtua Medical Group since 2012. In 2017, he opened the [Cherry Hill Free Clinic](#), whose mission is to provide free primary care to uninsured individuals in South Jersey. He received recognition in South Jersey Biz’s Who’s Who in Health Care 2019 for his work at the clinic and was awarded the Dorothy Cox Fisher Award for Community Service in 2018. Dr. Oyeyemi graduated Summa Cum Laude from Lincoln University of Pennsylvania and earned his medical degree from the Penn State College of Medicine. He completed his internal medicine residency at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital.
