

The Bristol Myers Squibb Foundation New Jersey Safety Net Innovation Program ("NJ SNIP")

The Bristol Myers Squibb Foundation ("BMS-F") is launching **NJ Safety Net Innovation Program** (NJ SNIP), a new grant program to advance health equity by supporting safety net healthcare organizations across New Jersey. The goal of NJ SNIP is to help increase access to quality healthcare for underserved communities in New Jersey by expanding safety net organizations' capacity to serve local needs while aligning with broader statewide goals and policy initiatives.

The BMS-F is working with the Camden Coalition to provide flexible funding and technical assistance to enable grantees to strengthen their organizational capacity and address a critical health need facing their community.

Selected organizations will receive:

1. Grant funding: Eligible organizations can apply for up to \$150,000 per year* for two years to address a community and/or strategic capacity-building need. Up to 10 organizations will be selected for the 2023-2025 grant period.

2. Technical assistance and capacity building: Grant recipients will receive one-on-one assistance from Camden Coalition experts, focused on ensuring the success of the proposed project and to sustain strategic growth through other funding streams, partnership-building, and alignment with state priorities. Grantees will have access to Resilia, an online platform that delivers technical assistance, coaching, and capacity-building support to non-profit organizations.

* not to exceed 15% of the organization's annual operating budget.

Eligible organizations: To participate in this grant opportunity, applicant organizations must be a nonprofit with 501(c)(3) status, located in NJ, and qualify as one of the following four organization types:

- ▶ Federally qualified health center (FQHC) / Community health center (CHC) and "look alike"
- ▶ Free and charitable health clinic
- ▶ Essential/Safety-net hospital
- ▶ Regional Health Hub
