This course is a unique learning experience that will reshape the way you interact with and deliver care to individuals you work with. Participants can expect to learn concrete behaviors that will elevate patient engagement, patient outcomes, and lead to sustainable change.

- Apply underlying COACH care tenets such as motivational interviewing, harm reduction, and trauma informed care.
- Demonstrate building authentic healing relationships with individuals served and team members
- Integrate COACH foundational behaviors into routines, operations, and mindsets.
